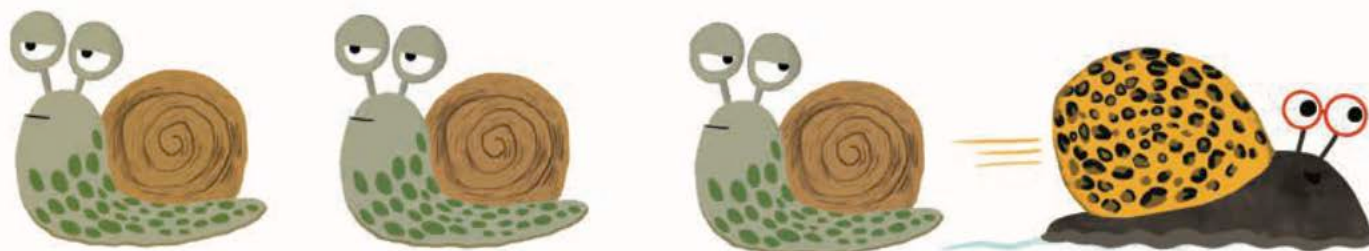

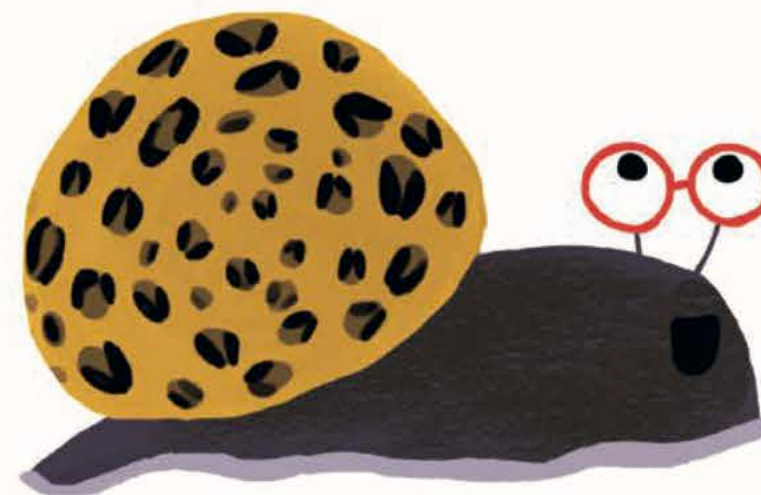

and then get old!"

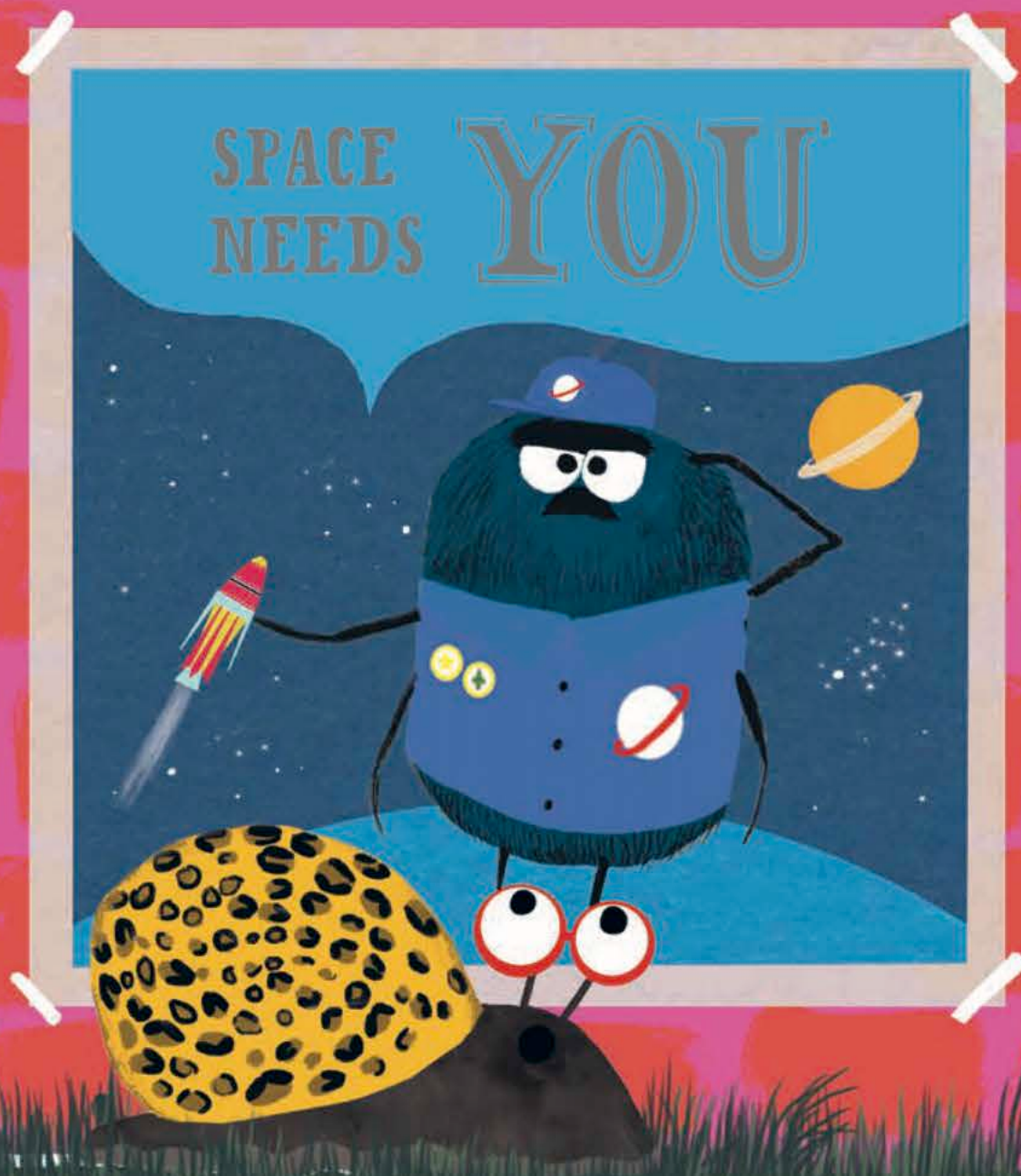
Don't dream too big. Don't make a sound.

BUT . . .

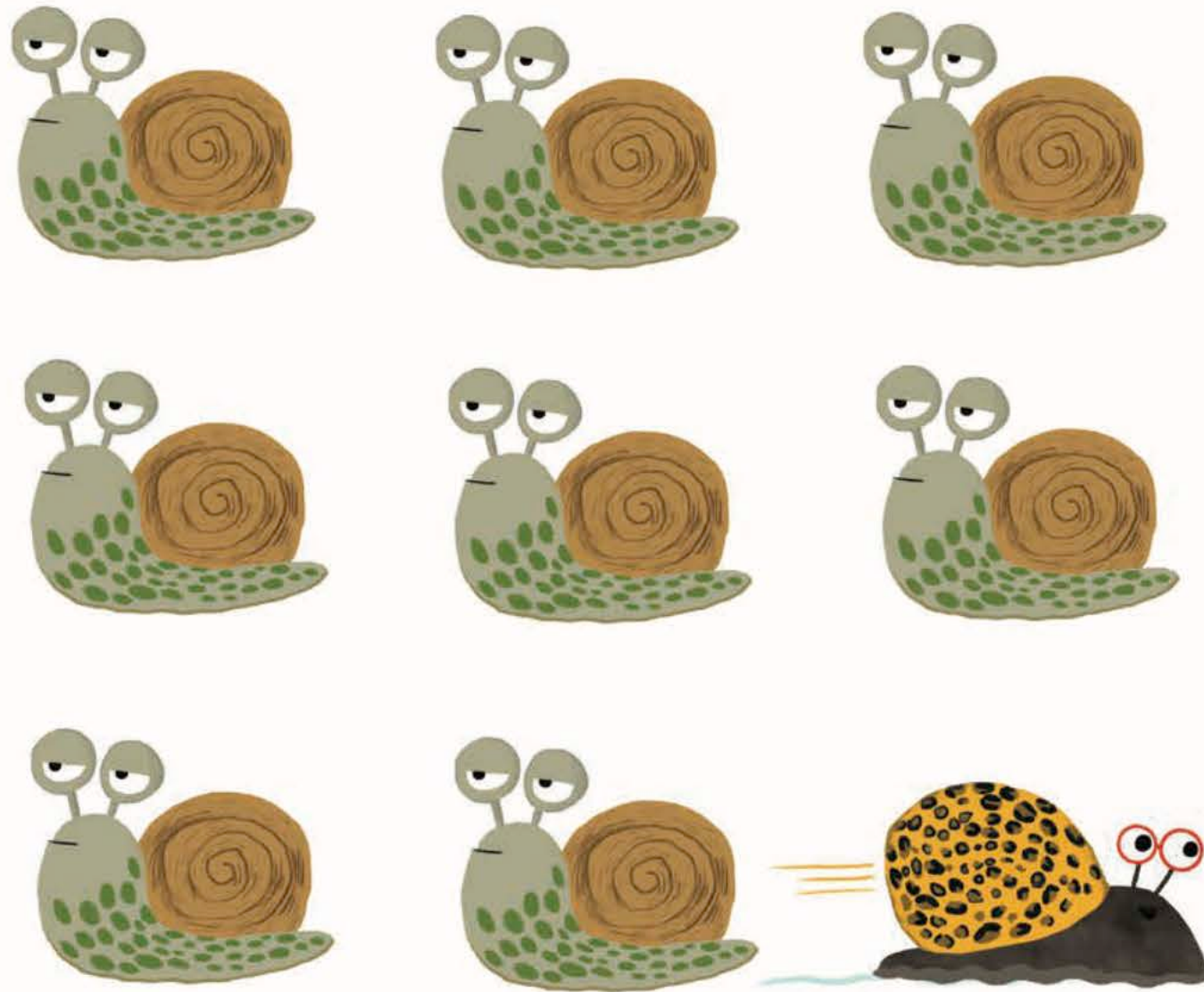


... Gail is not your average snail.

If all are zagging,



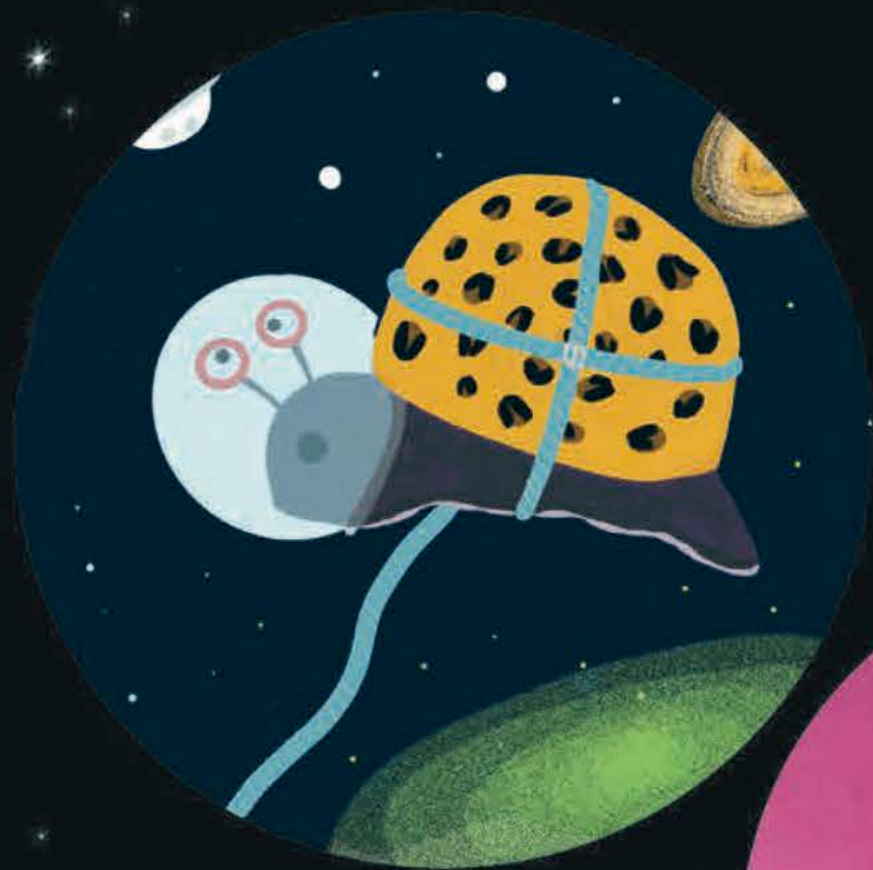
she will **ZIG!**
