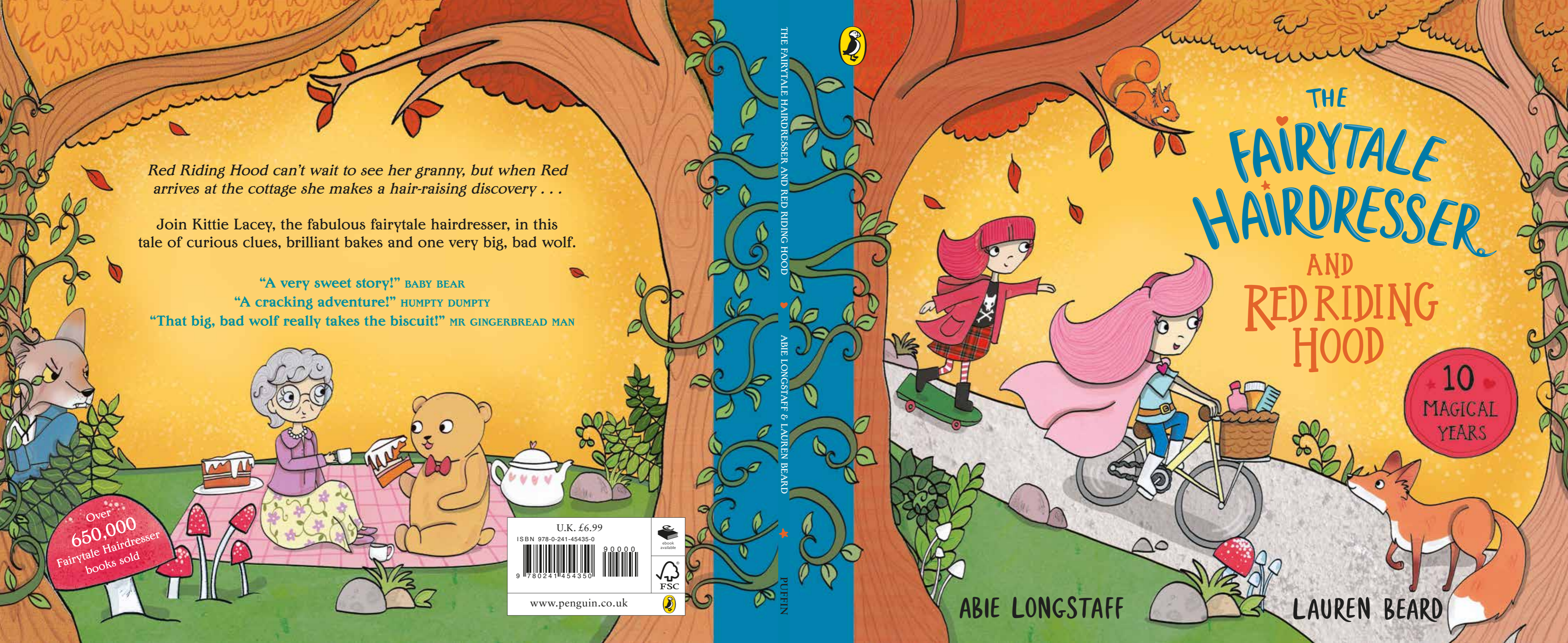

Kittie Lacey was the best hairdresser in all the land.

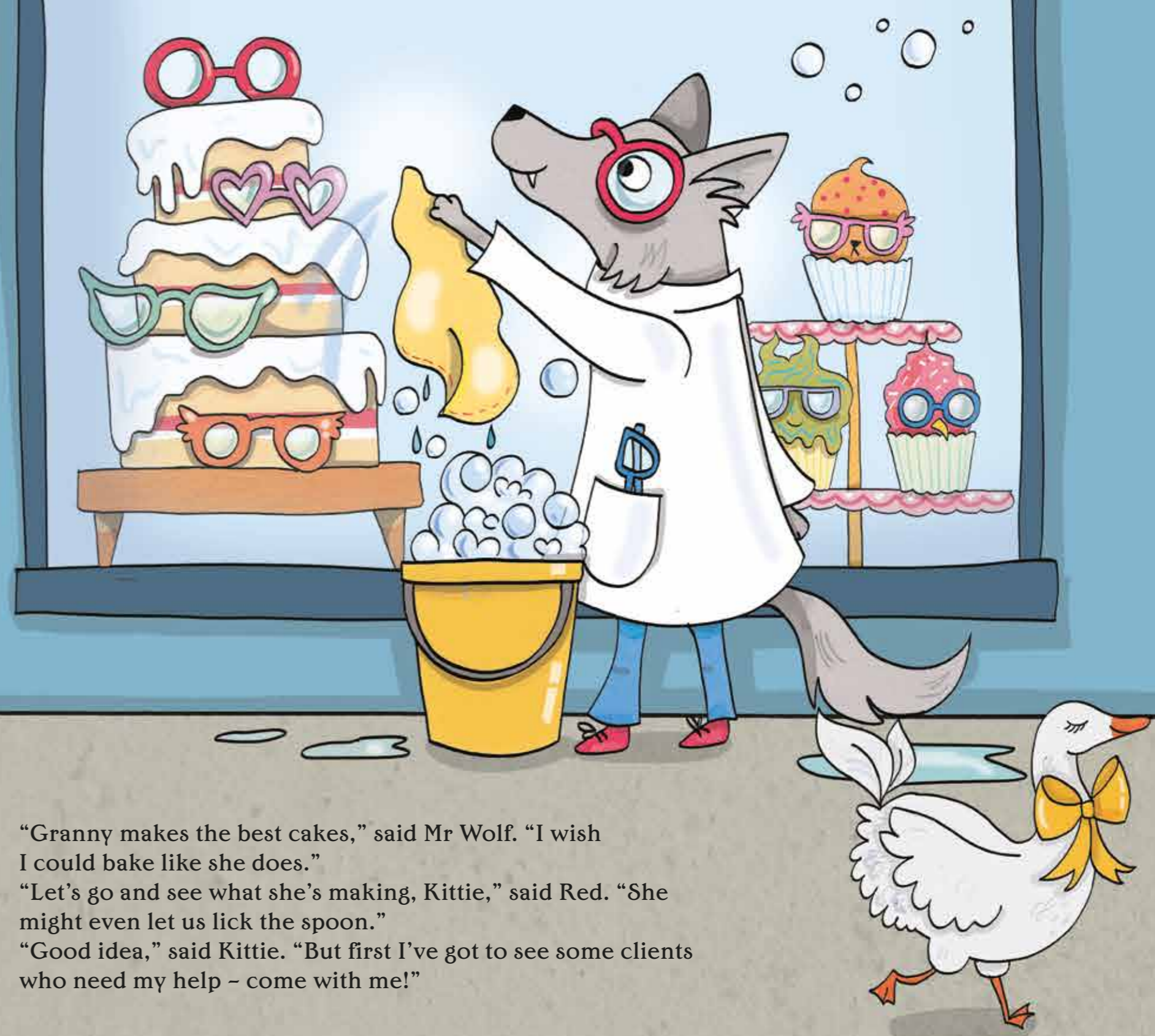

"Good idea," said Kittie. "But first I've got to see some clients who need my help - come with me!"

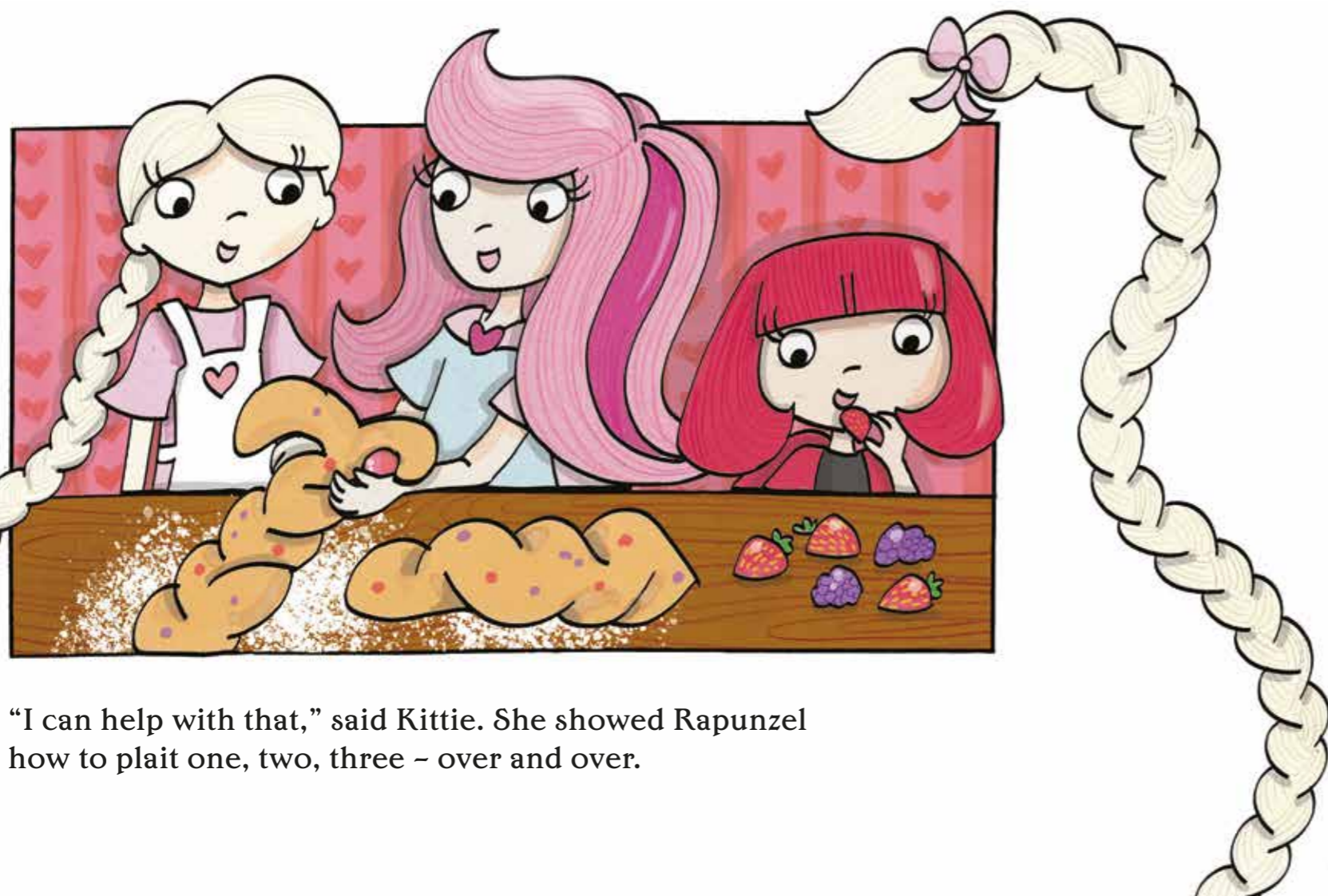
First, they stopped at Rapunzel's castle.
