Bernardo thought harder:

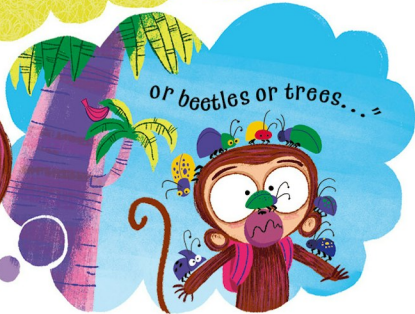


"Not parrots or bees."

"We can hunt those instead."



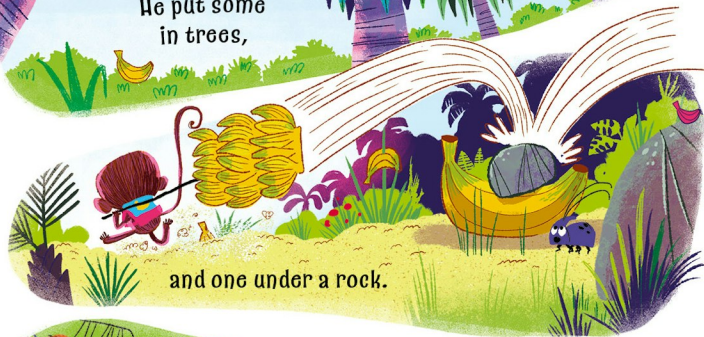
We found a
