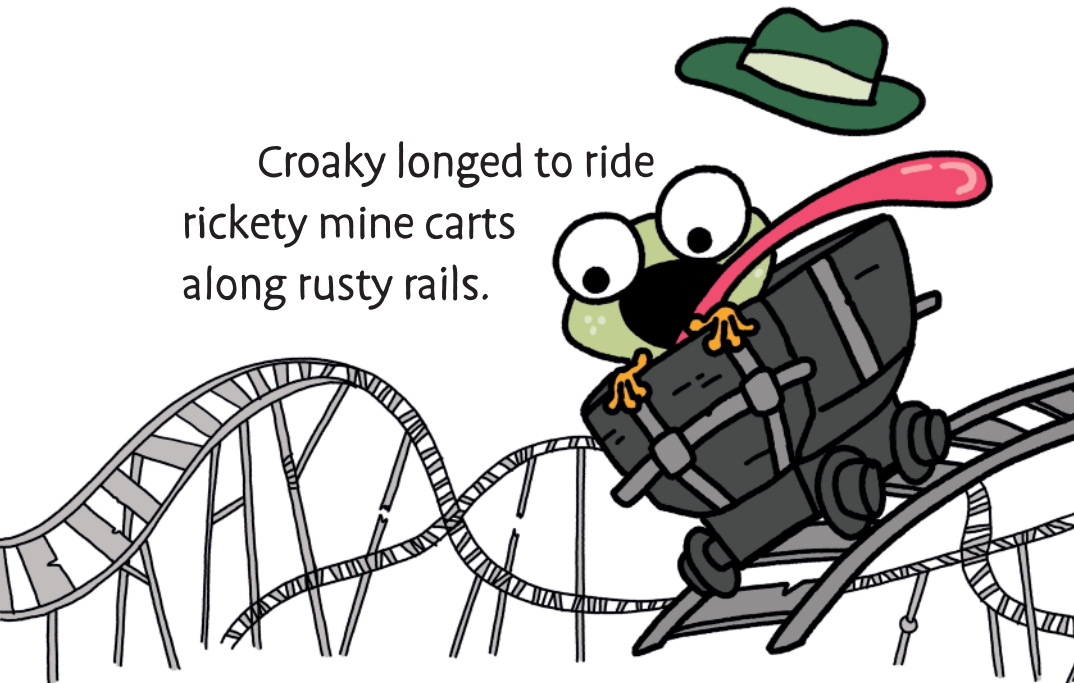
Ever since he was a very young frog,  
Croaky Hopper had craved adventure.



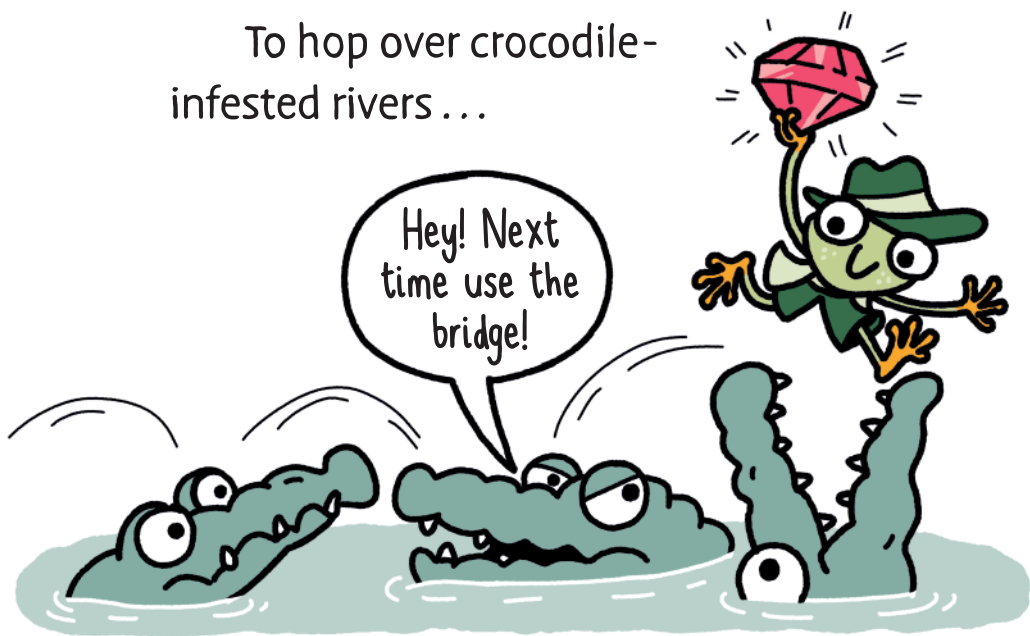
Croaky wanted to be like his hero from TV, Tennessee Toad. He was the greatest ever adventurer!
