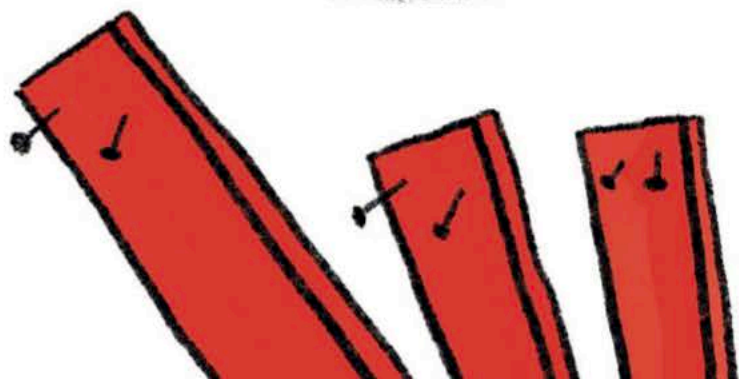
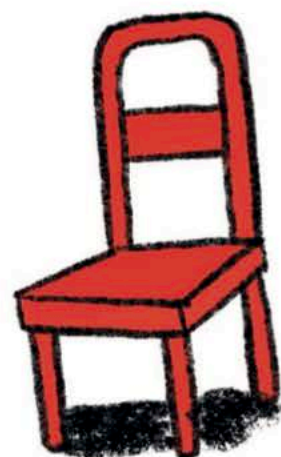
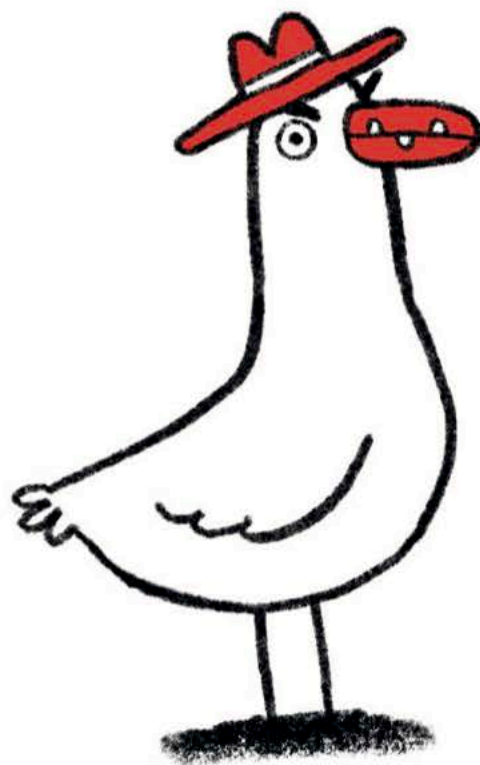
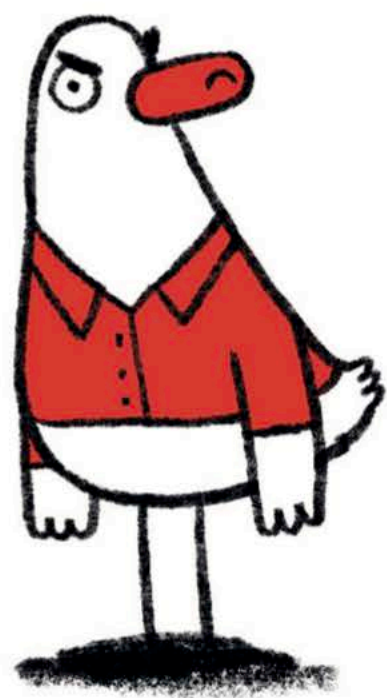
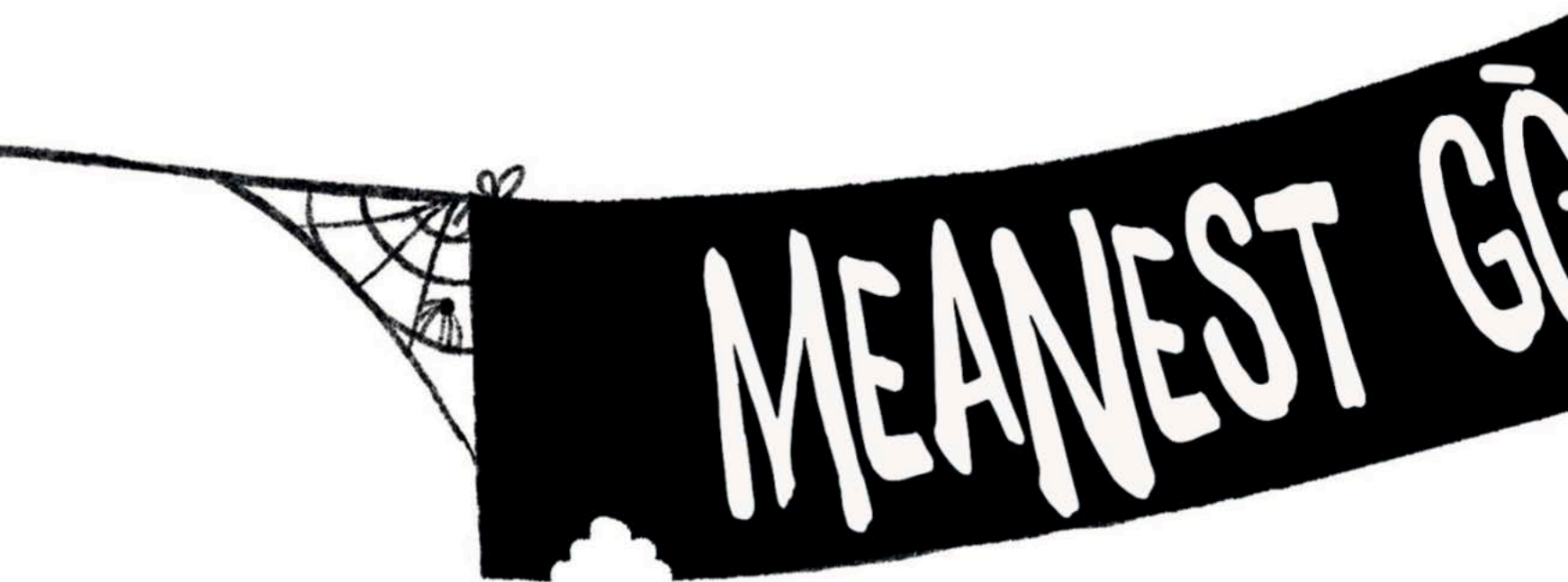


There are plenty of mean geese in the world.

of the Meanest Goose Society.



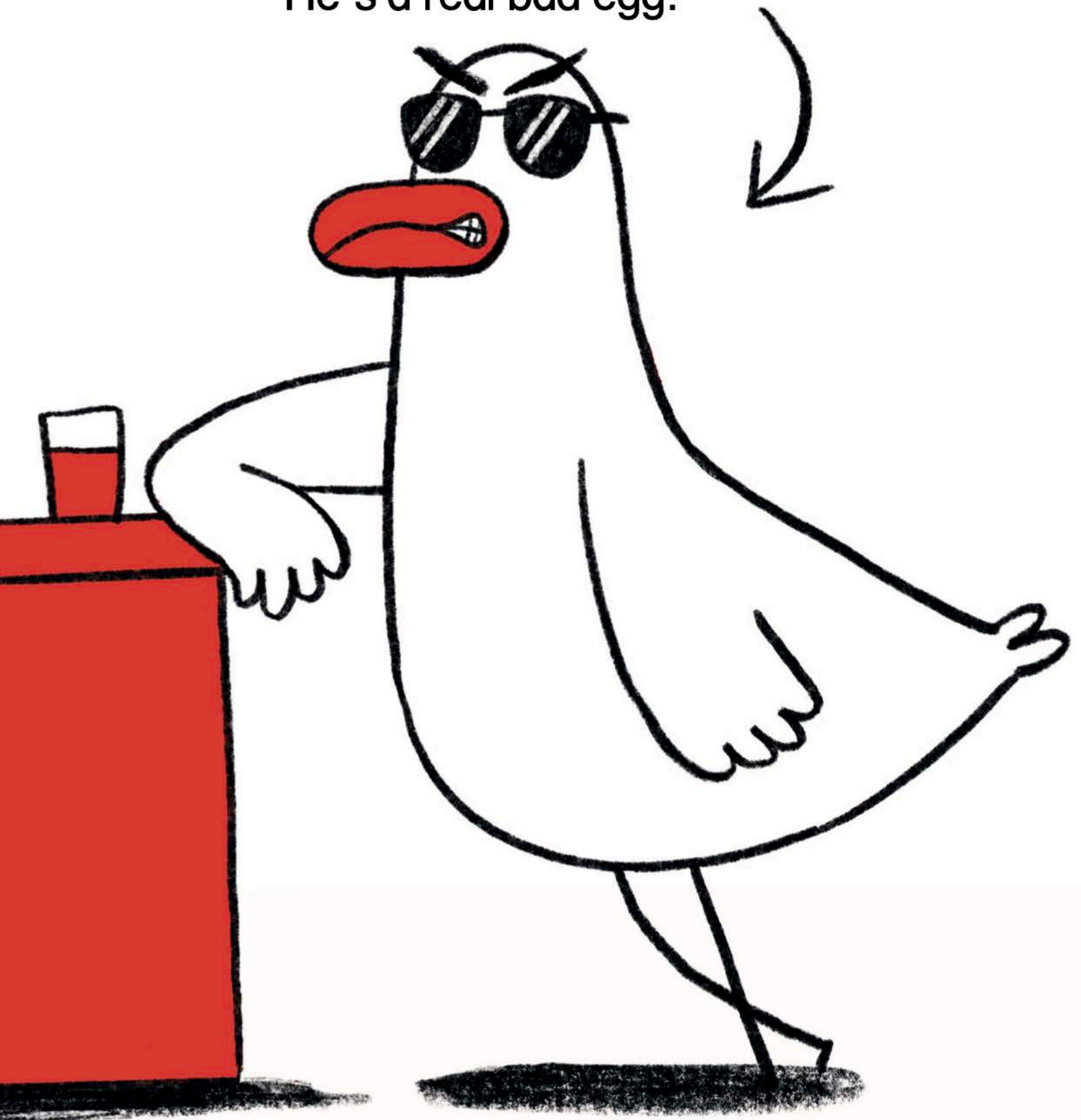


Keep your hands at your sides—

Look over there.

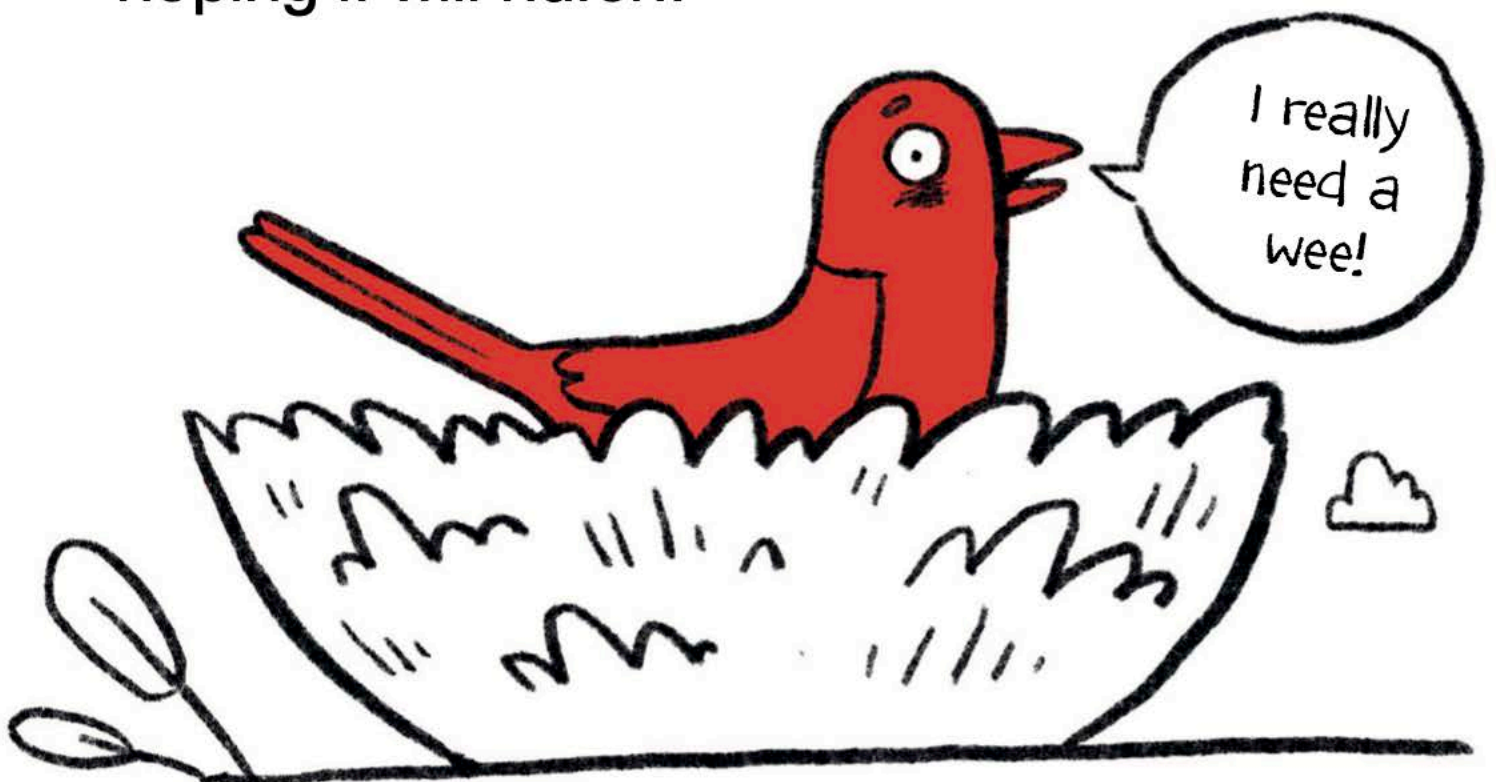
There's Jerry Coolshades.
He's a real bad egg.



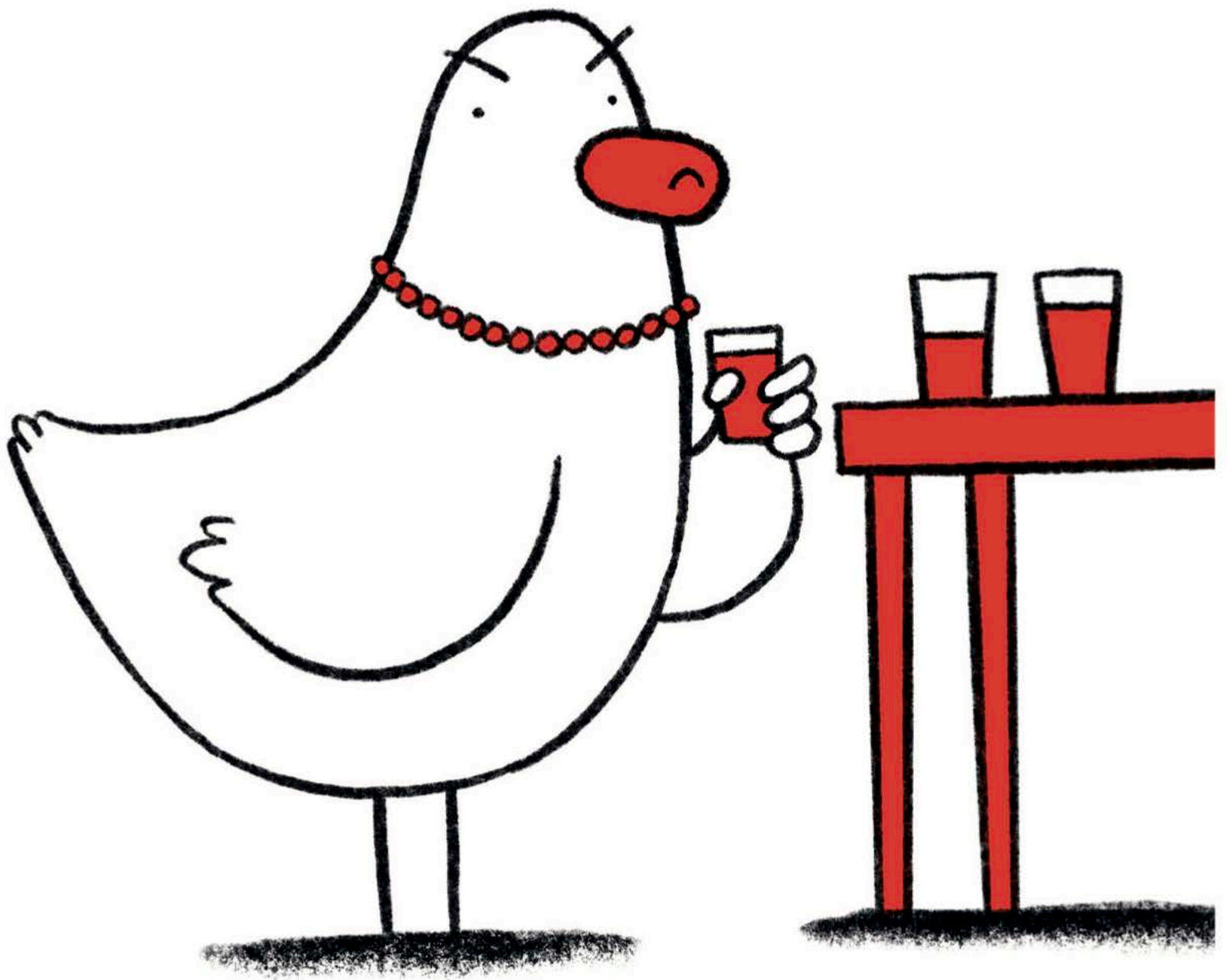

in Mrs Robin's nest.



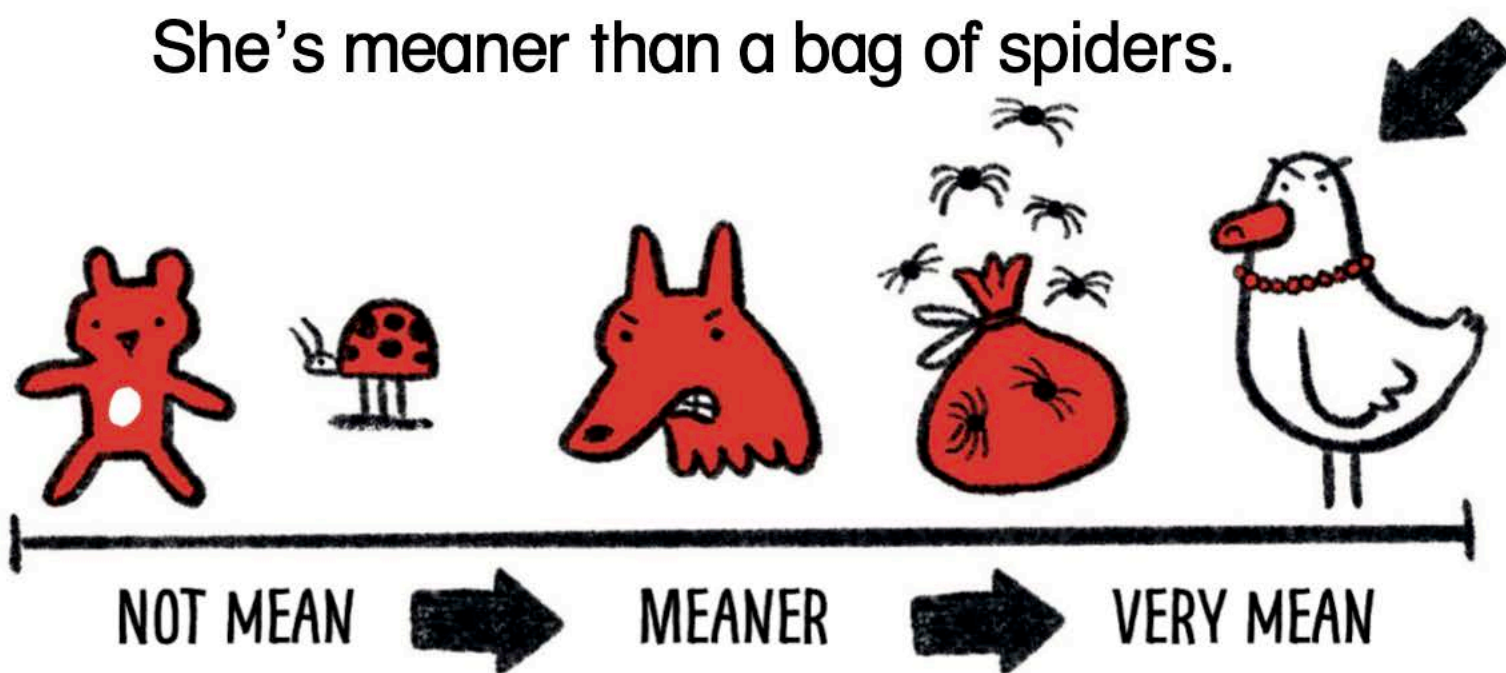
