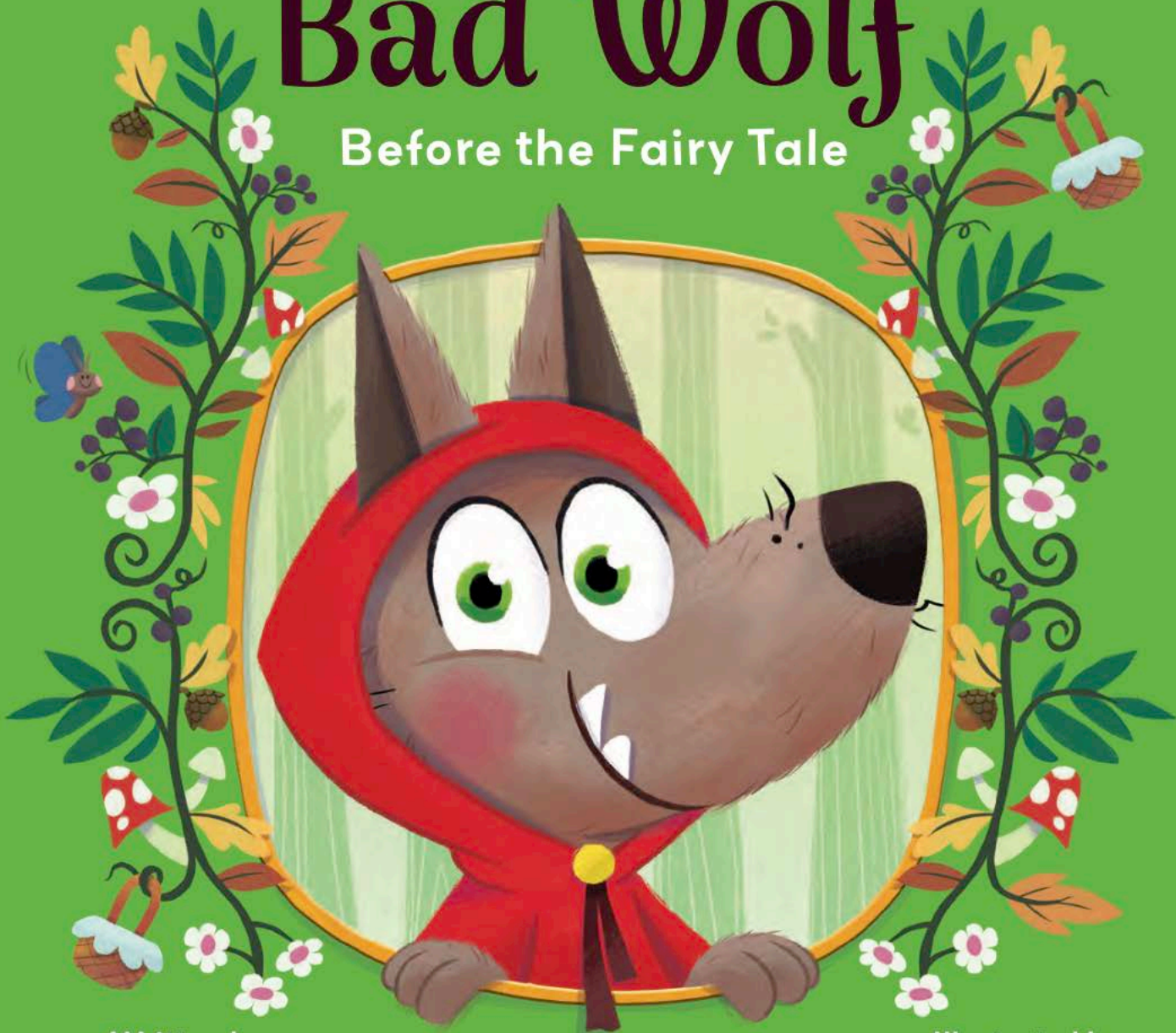

"You can't eat things just because they annoy you," said his mum.



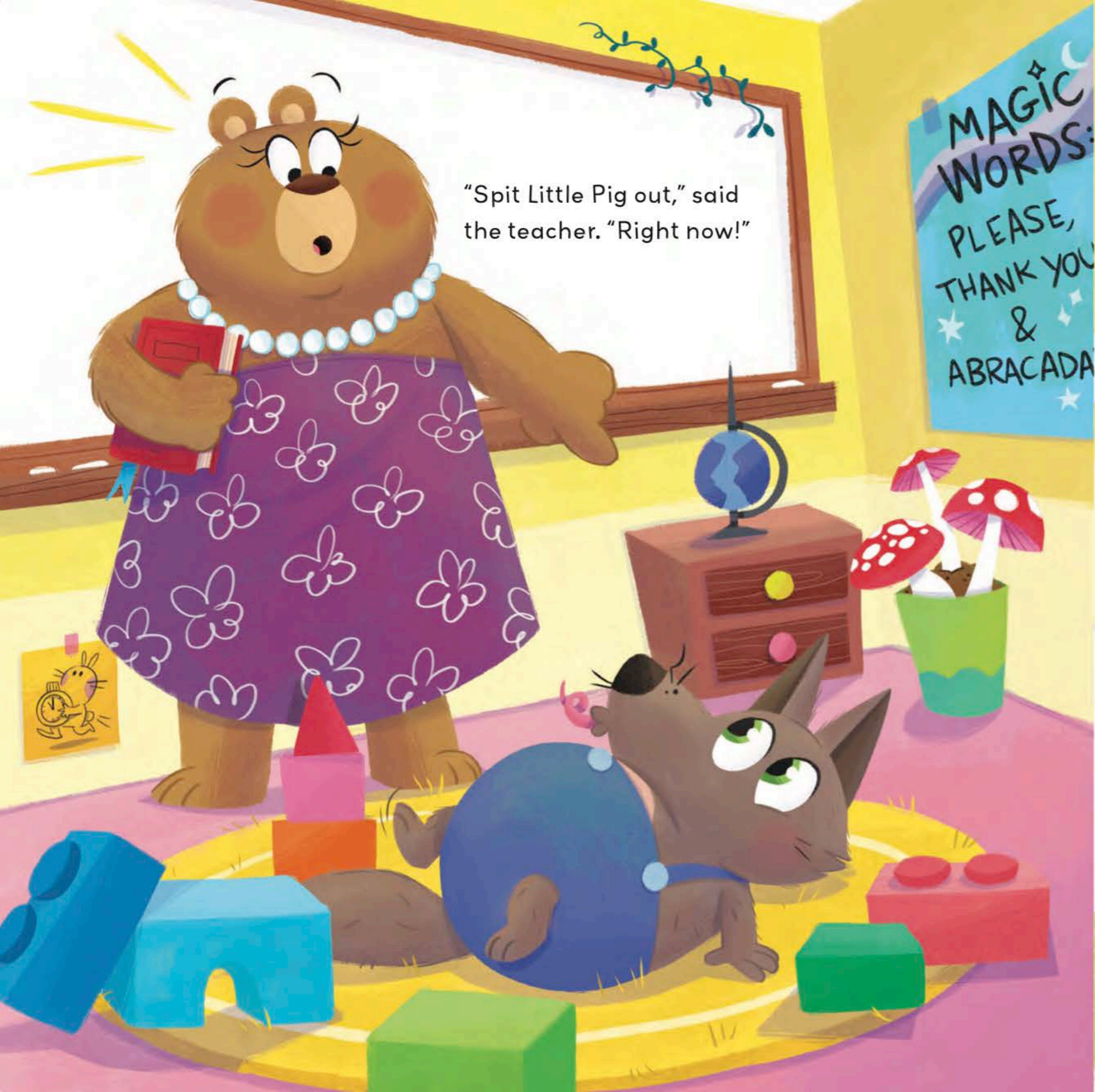
On his first morning at school, Wolfie ate the desk.
