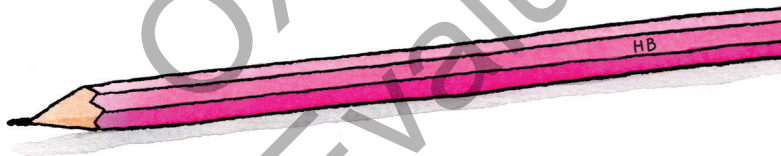

This is where lots of food is grown and distributed round Wiskling Wood by the produce train.



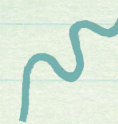
## Entrance and Exit points

# A Note on Wisklings

Wisklings are born from crystals, from the one Crystal Cave in Wiskling Wood.

The crystals begin as a tiny speck on the cave walls and take about eleven months to reach their full size, when they finally crack.

New babies stay in the Crystal Cave until their new parents come to collect them.

Crystal keeper



Wisklings are born from many different types of crystal, and wiskling crystals are different from those in the human world.



Some birth crystals are rarer than others, but being born from a certain crystal makes no difference to anything unless it is the extremely rare diamond.

Diamond babies are royal

The crystal keeper's job:

Keep a record of any new crystals, recording them in the official book.

Care for new babies until their parents can collect them.

In charge of the adoption list. Wisklings at the top of the list adopt the next baby born.

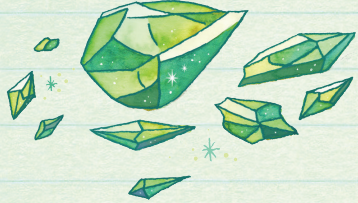


Crystal keeper



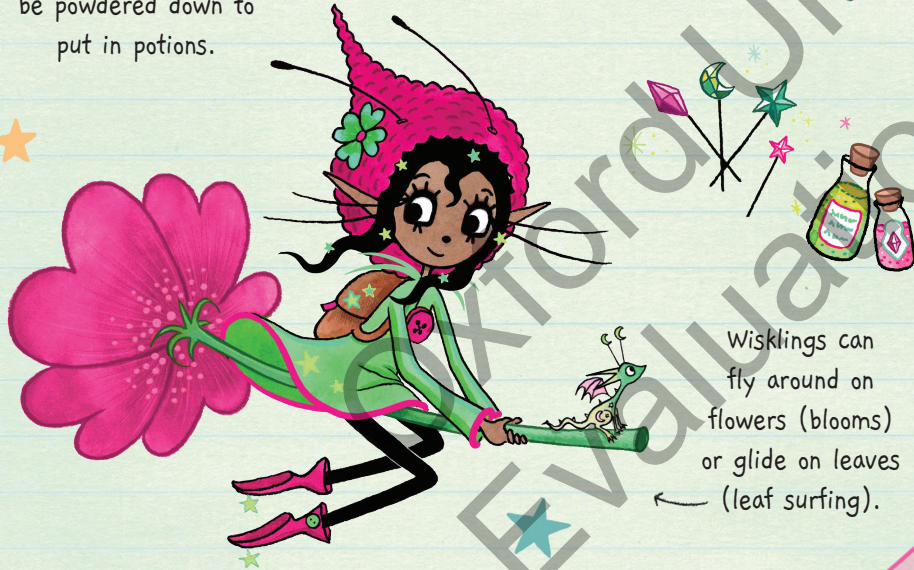
Birth crystal is very important to wisklings, and once they crack out of their crystal, the shards are sent off to the vaults for safekeeping.

Wisklings can fly around on flowers (blooms) or glide on leaves (leaf surfing).



Wisklings are born with teeny chips of birth crystal in the tips of their antennae. This is why their antennae can often spark when they feel any strong emotion.

Some wisklings have a few strands of natural 'tinsel' in their hair.

Wisklings don't have coloured irises like humans; their eyes are black.

Wisklings have black-tipped noses.

Pointed ears.

Wiskling girls are born with super-long eyelashes.

Any moles, freckles, or beauty spots are made from birth crystal.

Wisklings can live to 160 years old.

Wisklings have blue blood.

Wisklings can grow to around 12 cm tall. (Not including antennae!)





There are lots of plants and flowers that wisklings can eat, which are native only to Wiskling Wood.



Trumpet-cup flower milk is very good for wiskling babies.

Starflower petals have sugar crystals on them.



Most wisklings love nature and they live harmoniously alongside it.

A lot of the trees in Wiskling Wood are hollow so wisklings can live inside them. Wisklings also build houses and shops between the trees.



Fashion designers sometimes make clothes from real flower petals. They are allowed to learn and use the anti-wither spell to preserve the petals.
