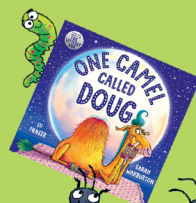
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

EYFS and KS1 Discussion Questions

1. Pam really wants to join in the fun in **THE BIG TREE**. When have you wanted to join a game or activity? How did you feel? What happened?
2. How do you think Pam felt when she was told there was “no room”? What could the squirrels have said or done to help Pam feel welcome from the start?
3. Can you think of a time someone made space for you? What did they do or say that felt kind?
4. Why is it important that everyone gets a chance to join in, even if the group feels “full” already?
5. What could you do if someone wanted to be included in your game, but the group was already busy or crowded?
6. How can we notice if someone is being left out? What signs can we look for?
7. Roger is a good friend to Pam and helps her feel like she belongs. Who helps you feel like you belong? What do they do that makes a difference?
8. At the end of the story, Pam invites the squirrels to play even though they haven’t been kind to her. Why do you think she does this? Would you have done the same?
9. Why do you think the story says, “There’s always a way to make room for us all”? What does that mean to you?
10. After reading the book, what is one kind action you’d like to try this week?

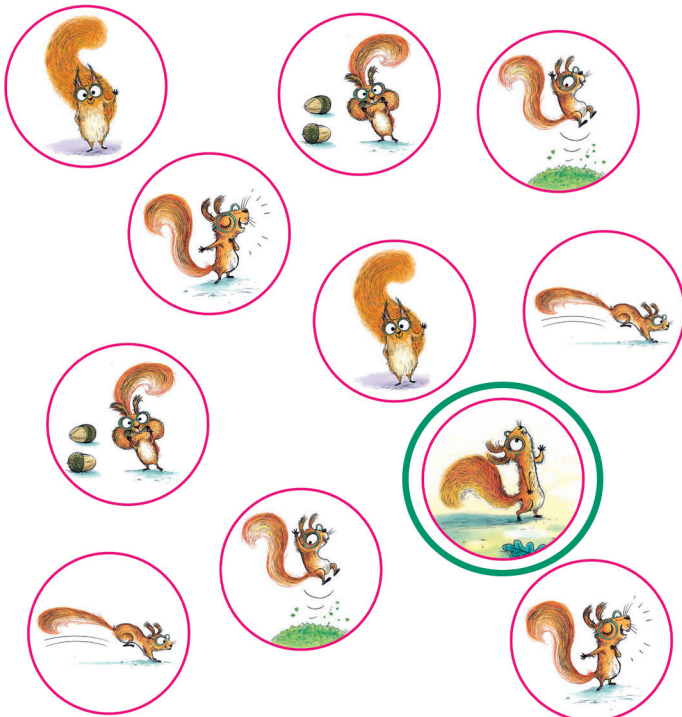
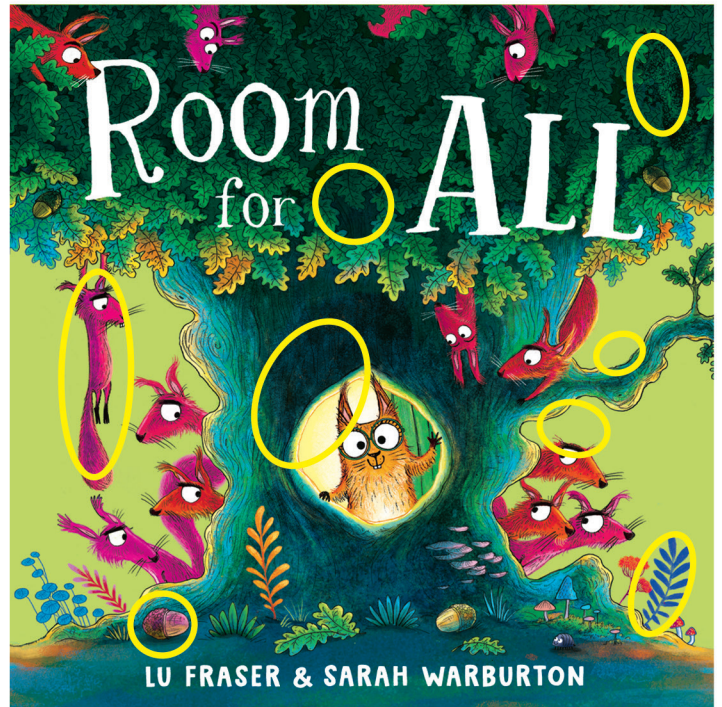
