And this is Moon.

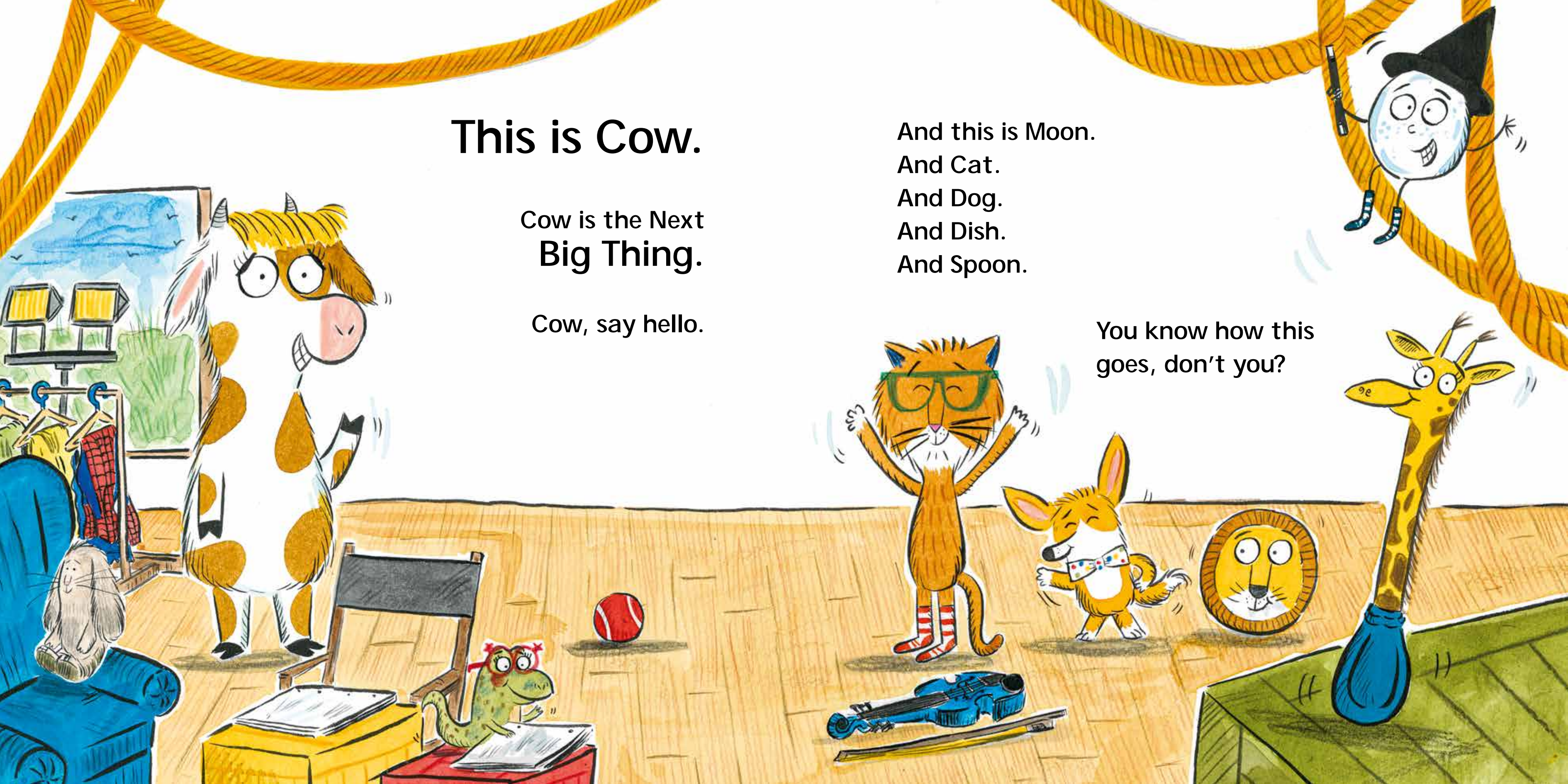
And Cat.

And Dog.

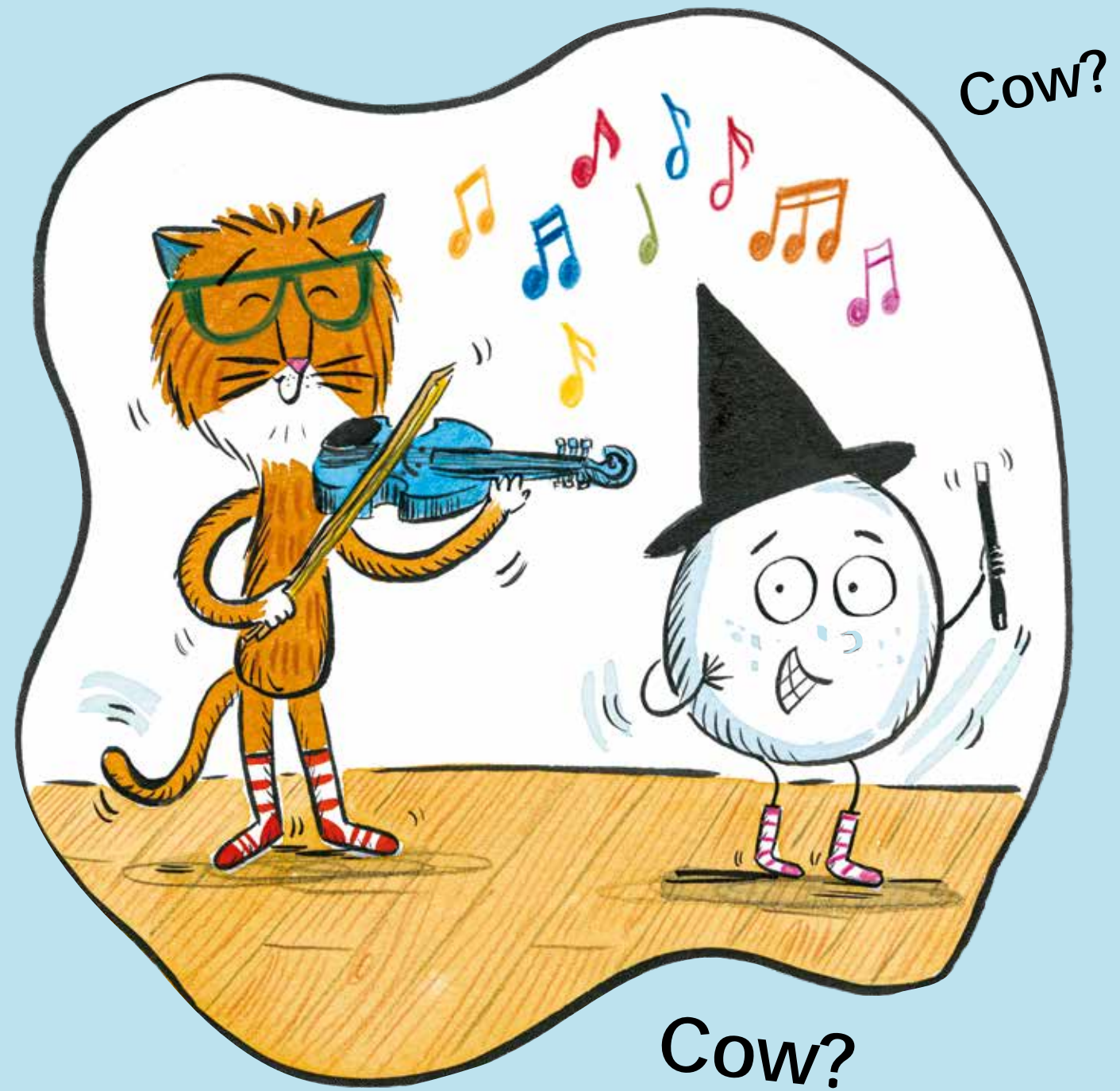
And Dish.

And Spoon.

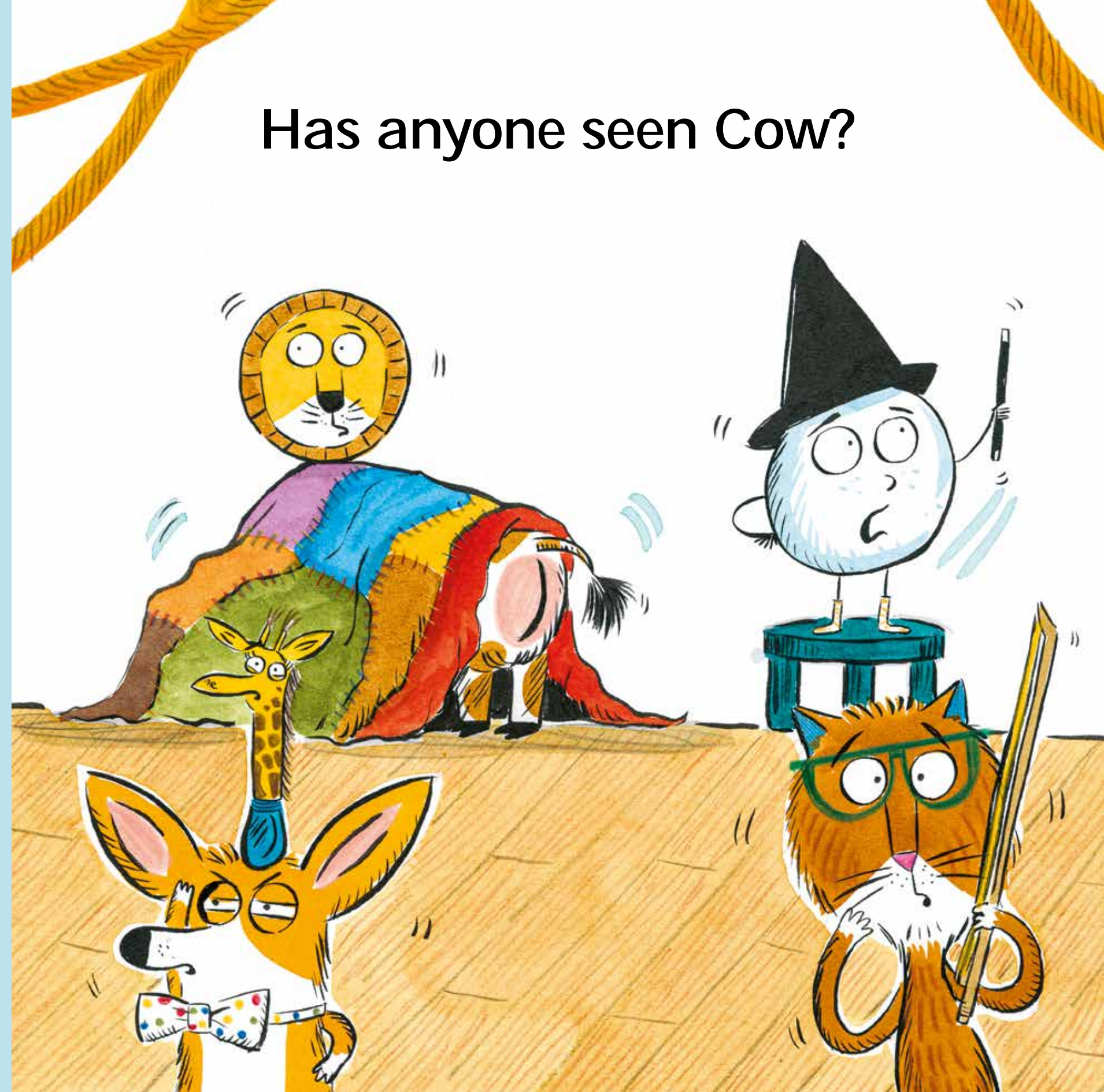
You know how this

The cow jumped over . . .*

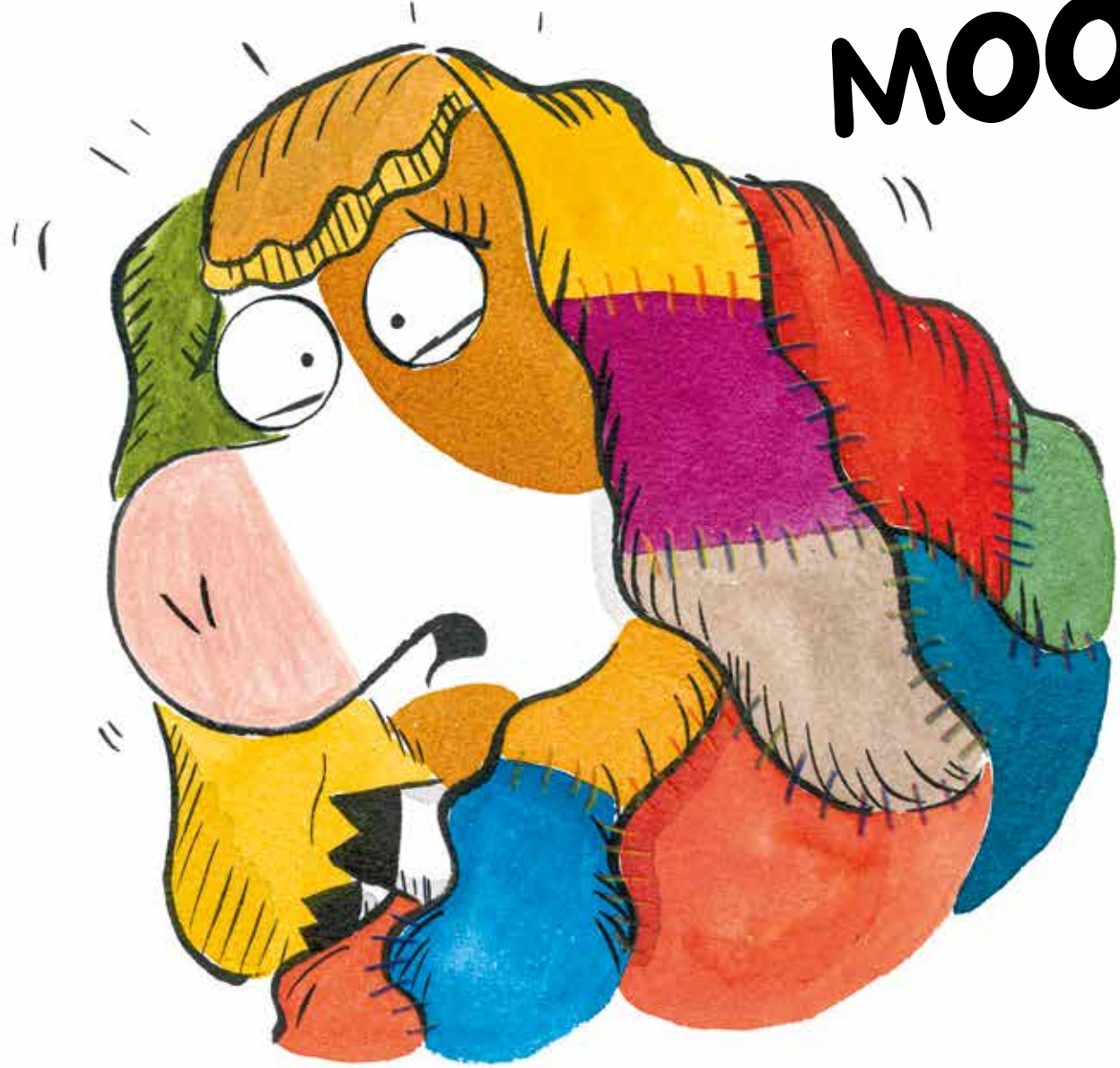


Has anyone seen Cow?

Hey Diddle Diddle.

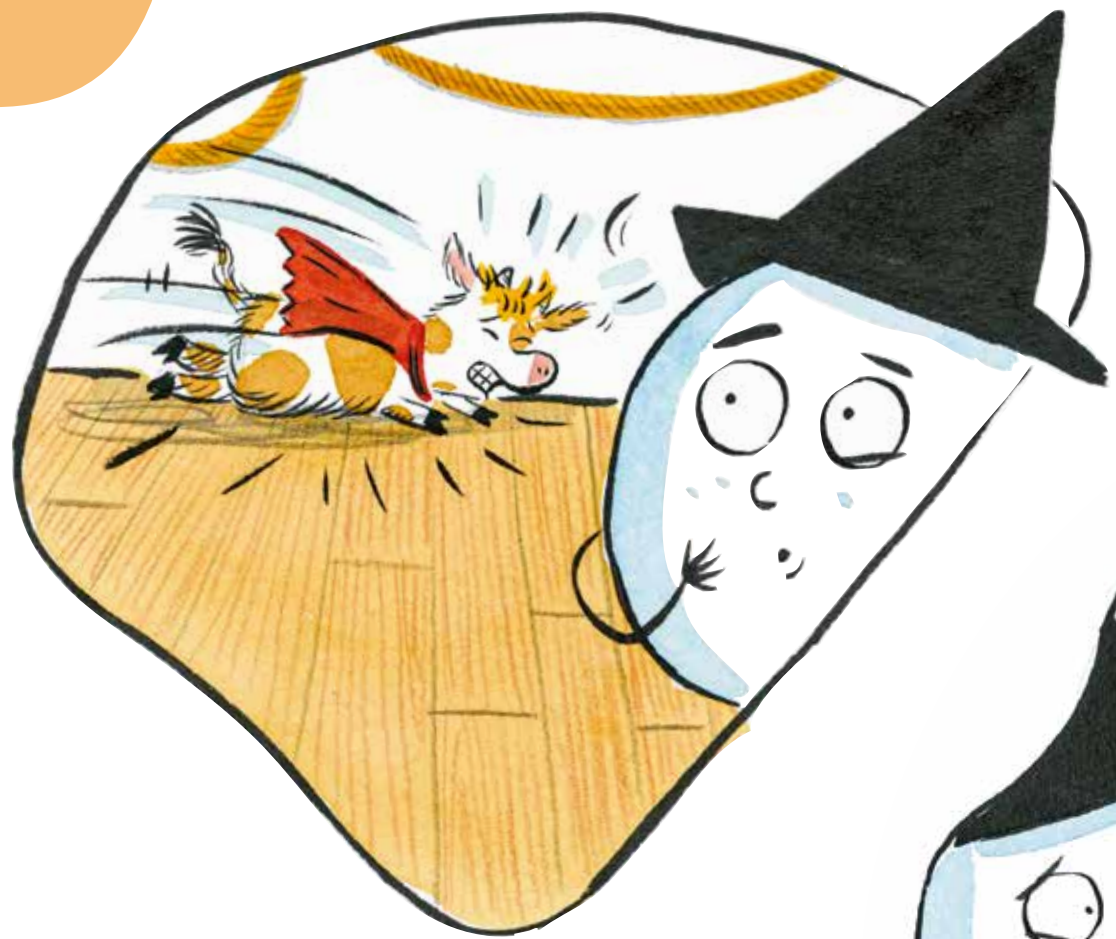
Okay, OKAY, you're right. I was too harsh . . .

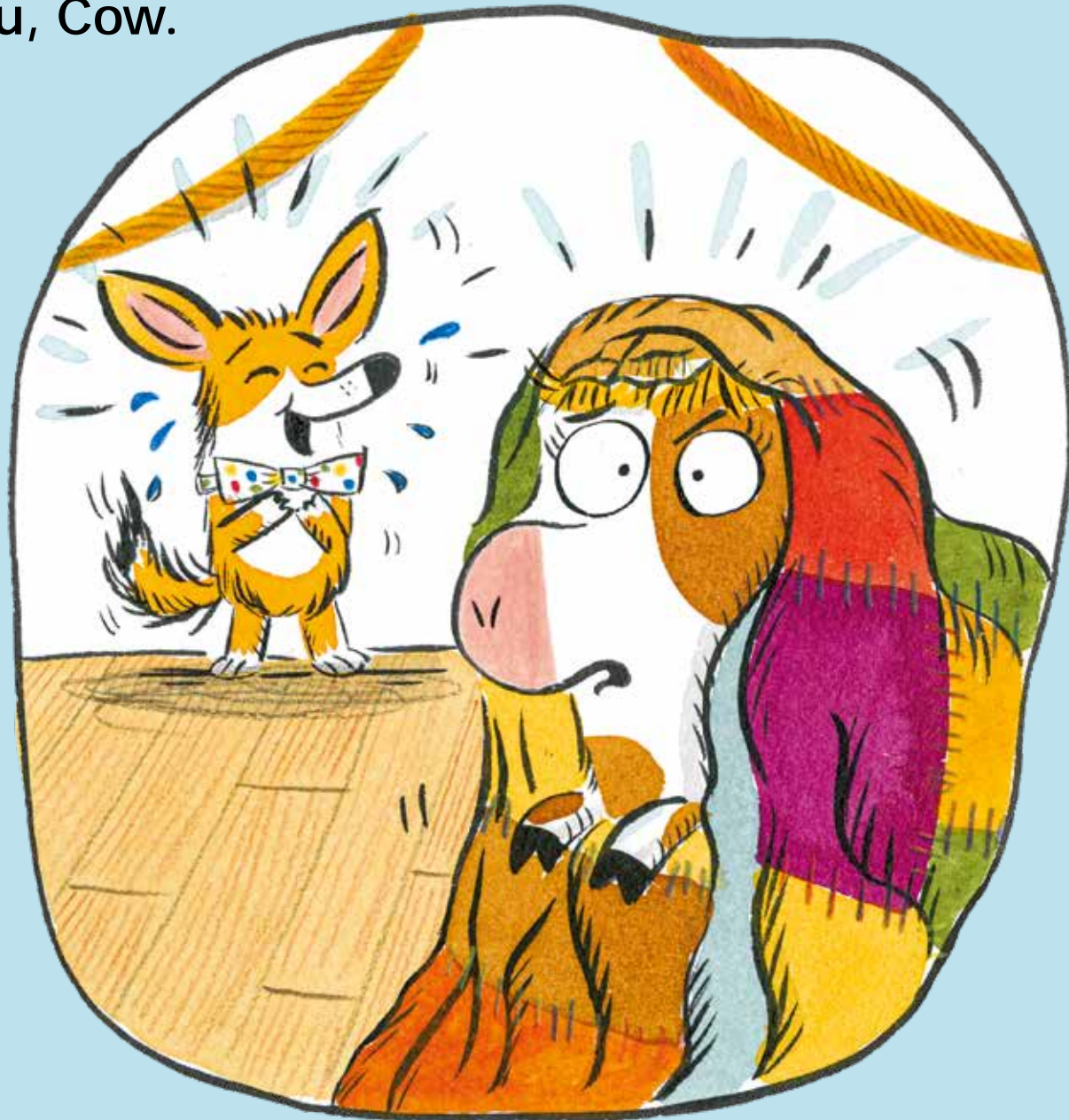

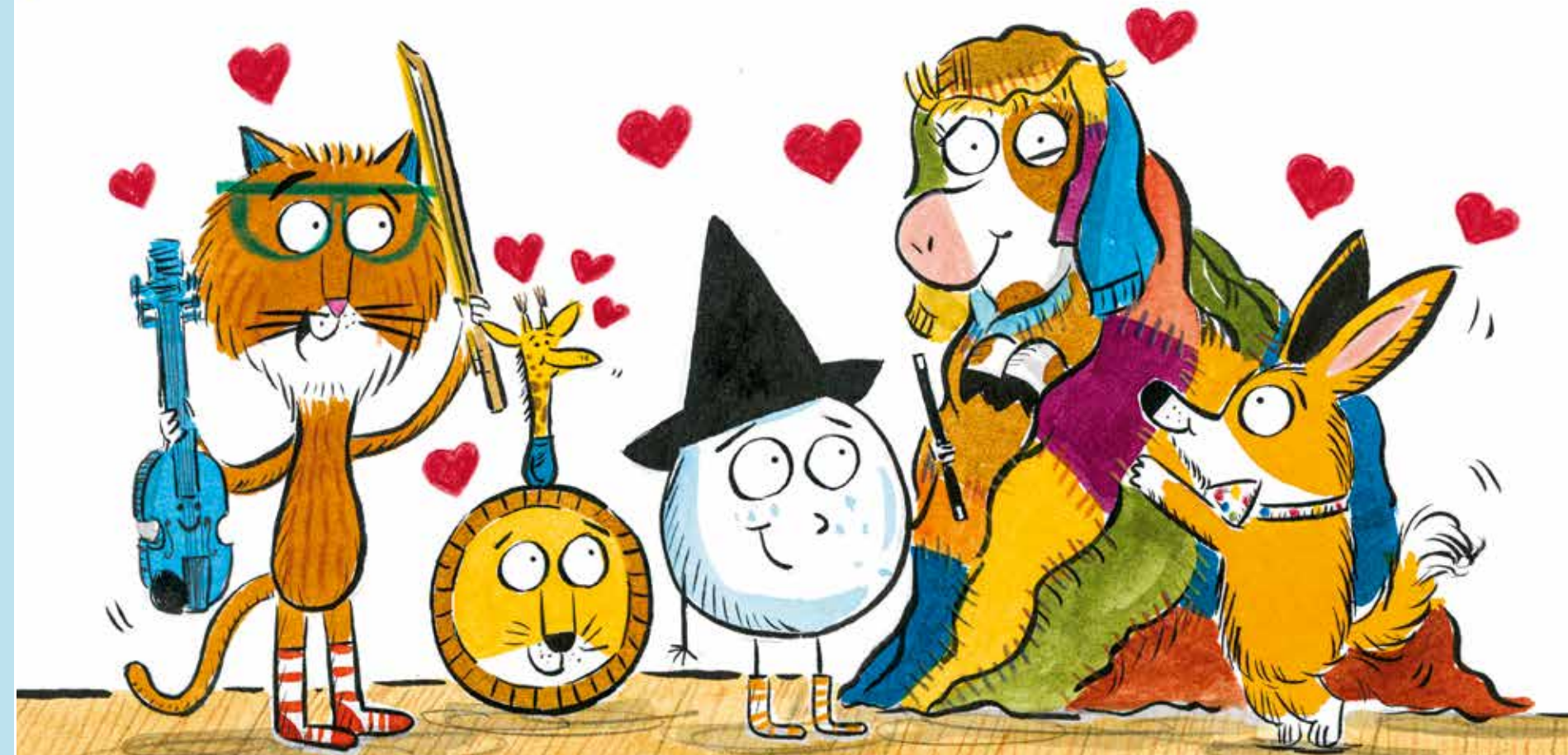

But that's okay!



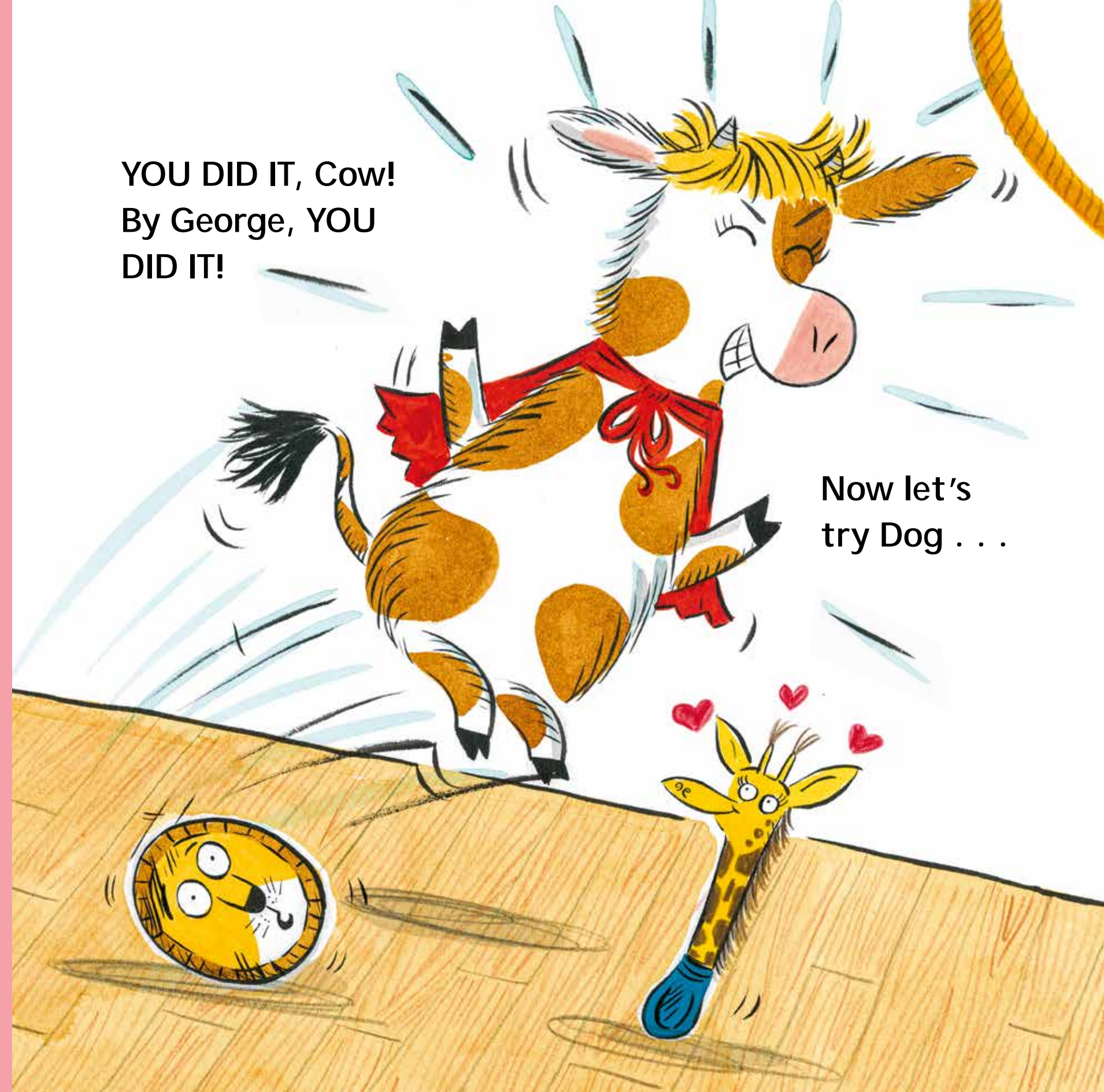
Look, I have an idea . . .

Like jumping over Dish.



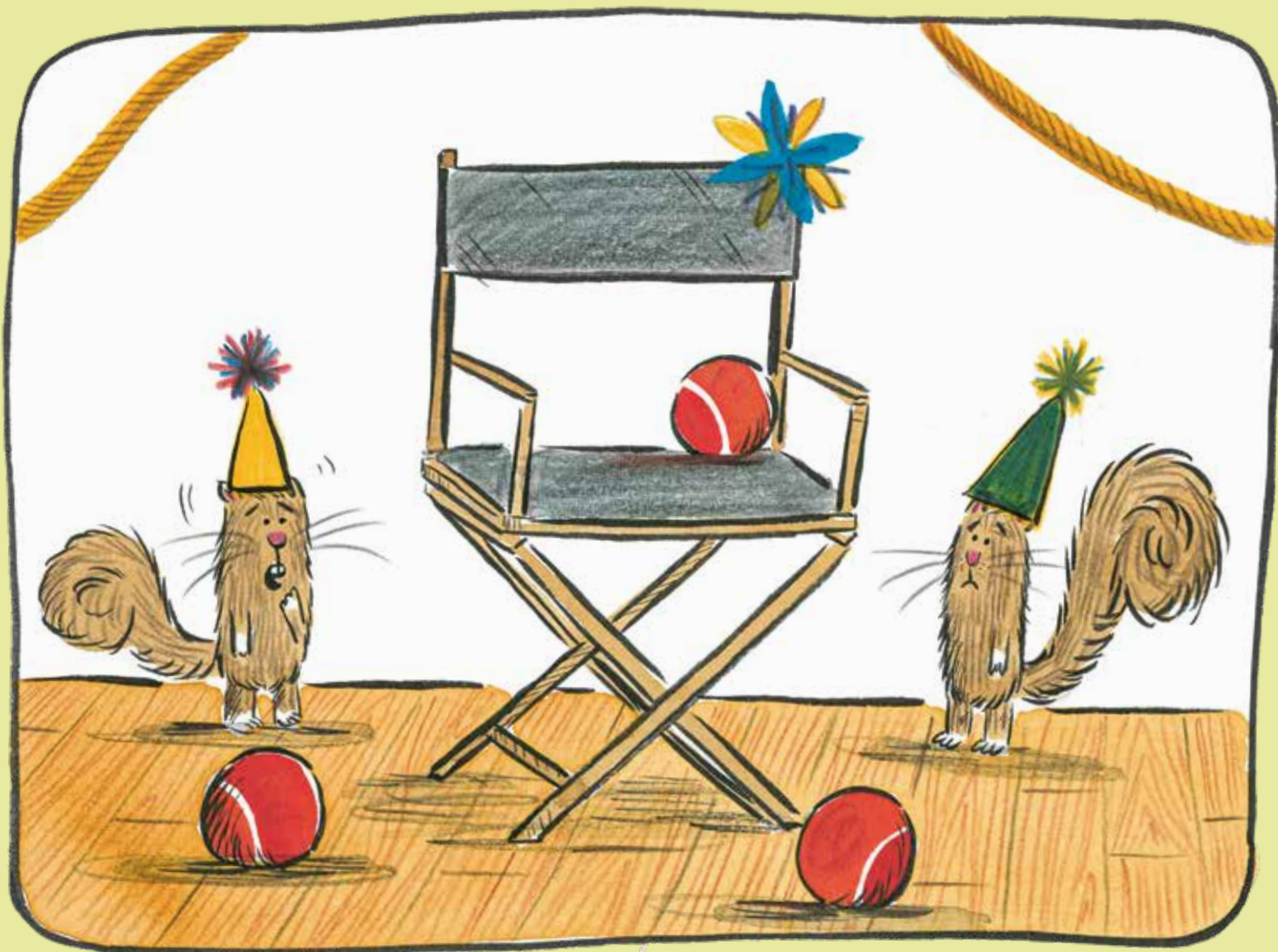
Oh, don't look at me like that.

DID IT!

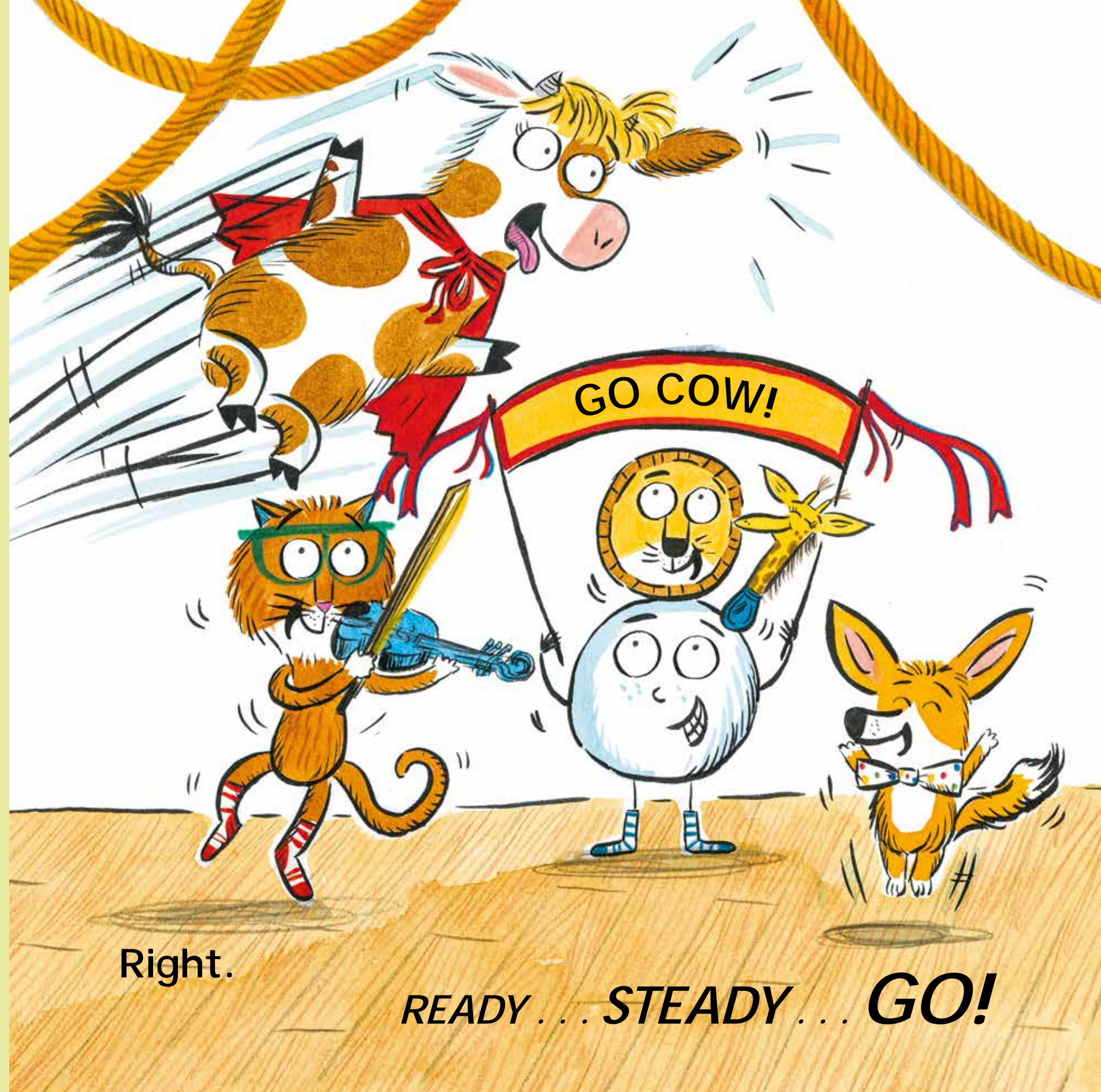


Now let's

READY . . . STEADY . . . GO!

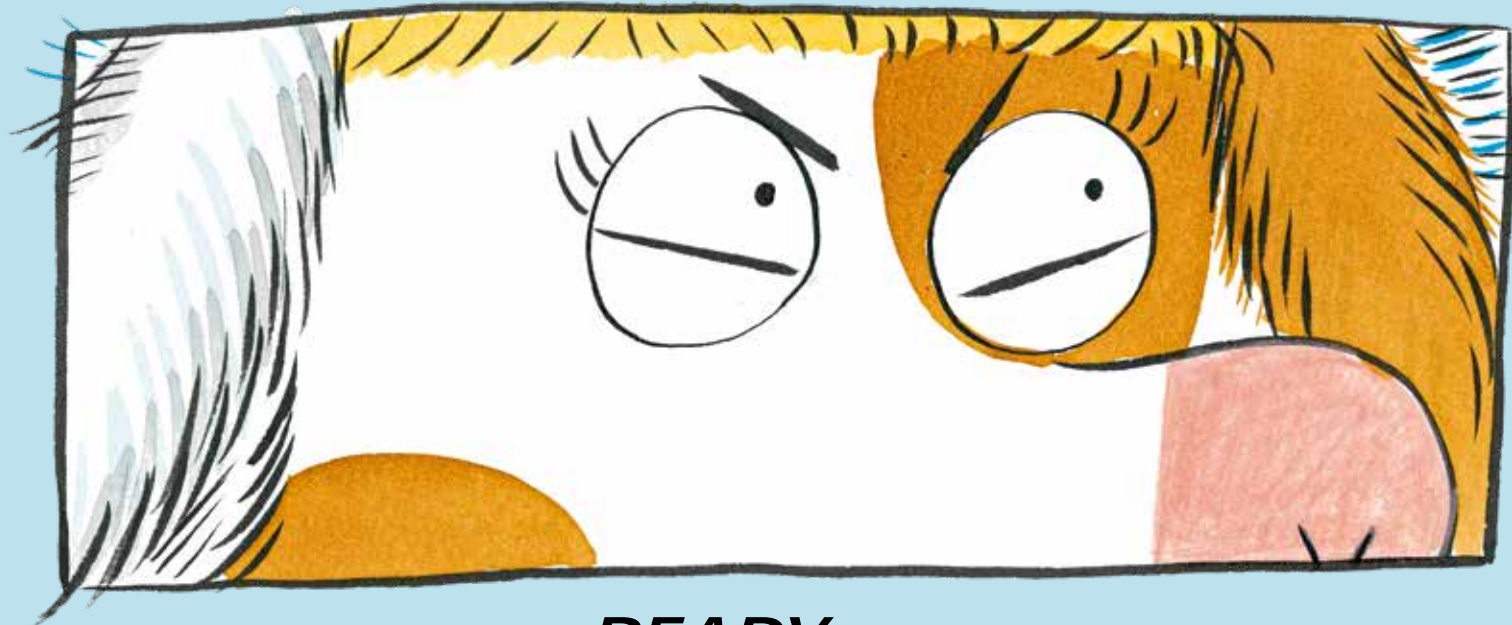
You DID it, Cow! YOU DID IT!
